Don's favorite quotes from the episode:

- When leaders say 'I don't know,' what happens is everybody wants to help you. Everybody wants to give you a point of view, tell you what they've been experiencing, and what they think we should do going forward.
- Clarity requires some level of stress. You have to be pushed to some level of discomfort. I wish I had been more conscious of this earlier in life. Today, if you bring me to places that I don't know, make me a little bit nervous and put me in front of a group, I feel able to find out things about myself and push myself to new places that I wouldn't have otherwise found.
